



Practice signing your name and introducing yourself in front of a mirror. Continue practicing and notice your progress. Which letters are easier? Which ones are more challenging?













It's time to learn how to count in ASL. We'll start with numbers 1-10.

Follow Sandra and practice using numbers 1-10. Once you've memorized each one, check it off below. You can always go back and watch the video again and again until you've got them all!








